Doubles matches will be no-ad scoring with a 10-point match tie-break in lieu of the 3rd set. Players are required to play singles and feed-in consolation. 	<p>Qualifiers: 4 qualifiers will be added to the draw based on the results of the Junior Nationals Qualifying tournament immediately preceding the Main draw.</p> <p>Any unused spots: TC Development or Out of Country Spots will be returned to Tennis Canada and not redistributed.</p> <p>In addition, players residing & training full-time outside of Canada may be granted an Out of Country spot upon review of their current international performance.</p> <p>Tennis Canada has the discretion to increase the draw size, via the awarding of development spots to the following individuals: players who do not meet their provinces published wild card criteria &/or players that are unable to qualify in their provinces Junior Nationals qualifying process, due to their participation in an official Tennis Canada Training Camp, or on an official Tennis Canada tour.</p> <p>In the event that an extra player is required to even the draw size, Tennis Canada will add a Lucky Loser from the Junior National Qualifying tournament.</p>
